**Courses of Fire - Stages 1 and 2**

**3 Position Rifle:** 60 shots, 20 prone, 20 standing and 20 kneeling on proportionate British Match BM/89 cards: 10 bull (prone), 5 bull (kneeling), 2 bull (standing) at 15, 20 or 25 yards.

**Small-bore Rifle:** 40 shots, 10 each at 4 proportionate British Match BM/89 cards at either 15, 20, 25 yards or 25 metres.

**20 yard Air Pistol:** .177" or .22" cal, 40 shots, 10 each on PL15 targets at 20 yards.

**Lightweight Sport Rifle, Standing, Precision:** Any sights, 40 shots, 5 each on PL14 targets or PL14 centres at 20 yards, PL19 at 25 metres or PL7 at 50 metres.

**Lightweight Sport Rifle, Standing, Timed (Standard Pistol Course):** Any sights, 60 shots, 4 strings of 5 shots each in 150

seconds, 20 seconds and 10 seconds on PL14 targets or PL14 centres at 20 yards or PL19 at 25 metres.

**Air Rifle 10 metre:** 40 shots, 5 each on 8 AIR2/89 or AIR3/89 targets at 10 metres or 1 each on 40 AIR1/89 targets.

**Air Pistol 10 metre:** 40 shots, **5 each on 8 AIR4/89 targets at 10 metres**

**Benchrest Any Sights:** 40 shots, 10 each on 4 proportionate **NSRA Benchrest Targets** at either 20, 25 yards or 25 metres. **Cartridge or air rifles allowed.**

**Cartridge Pistol:** 40 shots, 10 each on PL14 targets or PL14 centres at 20 yards, PL19 targets at 25 metres or PL7 at 50 metres.

**Entries to be received by 5<sup>th</sup> DECEMBER 2018**

**All entrants are eligible for a Free Prize Draw.**

**ENTRY FEE PER PERSON: £8.50 PER EVENT, 2 entries for £12 OR £15.00 FOR 3 ENTRIES BY AN INDIVIDUAL IN ANY ONE EVENT. (Juniors must be under 18 at 31 December 2018).**

**Individual Shoot fired in three stages.** Competition starts on receipt of stickers etc.

**1st Stage: Postal** to be shot by 28<sup>th</sup> JANUARY 2019. Scores to be returned by 9<sup>th</sup> FEBRUARY 2019.

**2nd Stage: Postal** to be shot by 20<sup>th</sup> MAY 2019. Cards to be received by the appointed scorers by 25<sup>th</sup> MAY 2019.

**Finals:** SEE STAGE 3 FINAL DETAILS below.

**Competitors are encouraged to use Eley ammunition in the qualifying stages**  
**Eley Ammunition MUST be used in the Finals, including Air**

**Stage 1** to be shot by 28<sup>th</sup> JANUARY 2019.

**Stickers** will be issued by NSRA. They must be attached to the front of the appropriate NSRA cards by an accredited club official before the targets are shot. **EACH SET OF TARGETS MUST BE SHOT ON A SINGLE DAY.**

**Scoring:** Once again we are asking club or match secretaries, or their nominees, to score the targets for the first stage in each club (a) to save clubs postage on a great number of targets and (b) to reduce pressure on appointed scorers.

**The score sheets must then be filled in and sent to the NSRA. If making a multiple entry in any event, only the score for the best set should be returned.** **DO NOT SEND ANY TARGETS TO THE NSRA UNLESS REQUESTED TO DO SO.**

**Stage 2** to be shot by 20<sup>th</sup> MAY 2019. Qualifiers: **60%** of scores returned and equal lowest from Stage 1 shoot in Stage 2.

**From 2018 the number of Competitors progressing forward to the 2<sup>nd</sup> Stage has increased to 60% so that we can increase the number of finalists in some of the Disciplines**

**Competitors who return exceptionally high scores will be reclassified to the appropriate class**

Stage 2 will be the same course as Stage 1. **EACH SET OF TARGETS MUST BE SHOT ON A SINGLE DAY, AND MUST BE SIGNED, WITNESSED AND DATED AS PER N.S.R.A. POSTAL RULES.**

**Shot targets have to be sent to the official scorers.**

Top scorers in Stage 2, including equal lowest scores, will go through to the Final, but the number of prizes to be won will be limited as shown below.

**Stage 3** – Final

**ELEY AMMUNITION MUST BE USED IN ALL FINALS, INCLUDING AIRGUN**

**3 Position Rifle - Top 5 in each class A B** - (3x20) at 50 metres on Sius Ascor –(11<sup>th</sup> August) **at the National Rifle Meeting 2019.**

**Small-bore Rifle - Top 20 in each class A B C D E F** - 40 shots at 50 metres – (11<sup>th</sup> August) **at the National Rifle Meeting 2019.**

**Air Pistol (up to .22 cal) at 20 yards - Top 10 in classes A B C** - course of fire as Stages 1 & 2 – at Bisley on **12<sup>th</sup> October.**

**LSR Precision - Top 10 in each class A B C D** - course of fire as Stages 1 & 2 on PL19 at 25 metres – at Bisley on **13<sup>th</sup> October**

**LSR Timed – Top 10 in each class A B C** – course of fire as Stages 1 & 2 on PL19 at 25 metres – at Bisley on **12<sup>th</sup> October.**

**Air Rifle 10m - Top 15 in each class A B C D** - 60 shot course on Sius Ascor - at Bisley on **12<sup>th</sup> October.**

**Air Pistol 10m - Top 15 in each class A B C D E** – 60 shot course on Sius Ascor – at Bisley on **13<sup>th</sup> October.**

**Benchrest - Top 10 in each class A B C D** - course of fire as Stages 1 & 2 at 25 yards – at Bisley on **13<sup>th</sup> October.**

**Cartridge Pistol – Top 3 in each class A B** – 60 shots at 50 metres on Sius Ascor – at Bisley on **12<sup>th</sup> October.**

**Juniors** - in all disciplines, must be under 18 at 31 December 2018.

**FINALS PRIZES WILL BE AWARDED IN EACH CLASS AS FOLLOWS (SUBJECT TO ENTRY)**

3 Position, classes A & B	1st - 3rd
Rifle, classes A, B, C, D, E & F	1st - 10th
Air Pistol 20 yards, classes A, B & C	1st - 4th
Lightweight Sport Rifle (precision), classes A, B, C & D	1st - 4th
Lightweight Sport Rifle (timed), classes A, B & C	1st - 4th
Air Rifle 10m, classes A, B, C & D	1st - 5th
Air Pistol 10m, classes A, B, C, D & E	1st - 5th
Bench-rest, classes A, B, C & D	1st - 3rd
Cartridge Pistol, classes A & B	1st - 3rd

**Competitors who reach the Finals but do not shoot will not be eligible for a prize.**

Special medals will be awarded to all shooters who qualify for Stage 2. Silver and gold bars will be added to the medal dependant on advancement in each event – gold to finalists, silver for second stage. Only one medal, with appropriate event bar(s), will be awarded to any competitor.

**The leading Junior in each class in each event in Stage 2 will receive an NSRA Plaque.**
