HOW TO GET MONEY OUT OF THE GOVERNMENT FOR SHOOTING – YES, REALLY!

Q1. WHAT IS GIFT AID?

- Gift Aid is NOT like Live Aid, Band Aid, etc.; it does NOT involve any extra payment from you the member, over and above your normal subscription.
- Gift Aid is only a direct (but simplified) replacement for the system of Deeds of Covenant which were in use until 5th April 2000.
- Gift Aid enables a charity like the NSRA to recover from H.M.R.C some of the income tax paid by its members – money that can then be used to benefit our sport.

Q2. HOW DOES GIFT AID WORK?

1. You pay income tax to HM Revenue & Customs; either it is deducted from your income (salary, pension, savings interest, etc.) at source, or you pay it direct to the Revenue.
2. You give a Gift Aid declaration to the NSRA.
3. You pay to the NSRA your subscription from your taxed income.
4. The NSRA claims back from the Revenue the tax you paid on the income used to pay your subscription. Up until 5th April 2008 this amounted to 28p in the £. From 6 April 2008 it was reduced to 25p in the £.

Q3. AM I ELIGIBLE TO DO A GIFT AID DECLARATION?

- Have you paid or will you pay UK income tax or Capital Gains Tax (CGT) on any of the following in any tax year since 1st January 2012?
 - o Income from employment
 - o Pension (may be taxed at source)
 - o Income from investments
 - o Interest on savings (especially building society accounts, usually taxed at source)
 - o Capital gains on disposal of assets
 - o Other source of income
- If the answer is "yes" to any of the above, you can do a Gift Aid declaration.
- If the answer is "no" to all of the above, but you are under 18 and your subscription is paid by your parent who can answer "yes" to any of them, then they can do a Gift Aid declaration instead of you, even if they are not a member of the NSRA.
- If there is any tax year in which you have not paid any income tax or CGT at all, this should be noted when the declaration is made.
